

Television CAB Fee Schedule

Green Electronics Council Conformity Assurance Body (CAB) Effective for New or Renewing EPEAT Participating Manufacturers

Payment of the appropriate fee below enables an EPEAT Participating Manufacturer to declare to the Green Electronics Council's (GEC's) Conformity Assurance Body (CAB) their products' conformance to specific criteria of IEEE 1680.3, which covers televisions of all types, regardless of screen technology. The fee is paid annually.

In order for declared products to appear on the EPEAT Registry, the Participating Manufacturer must also sign an agreement with, and pay an EPEAT Participation Fee to, the GEC.

GEC CAB fees are for one year, beginning on the date of enrollment. The fees below apply both to new and renewing manufacturers of Television Products.

The GEC CAB fee is based on the Participating Manufacturer's most recent global sales of their branded products, stated in U.S. dollars. Global sales include all product types covered by IEEE 1680.3, which covers (televisions of all types, regardless of screen technology) whether or not those products meet EPEAT environmental criteria or are actually registered on EPEAT.net.
